Our latest result & updates

As the CHAISE project wraps up in October, we are excited to share its key results and outputs. This includes our comprehensive learning materials: an online blockchain skills and certification and a guide for trainers to deliver an impactful training experience. Additionally, the project has developed career guidance resources to support job seekers and employees. Our Blockchain Skills Forecast 2024 highlights the demand and supply of blockchain skills across Europe, utilizing both quantitative and qualitative data. Furthermore, the CHAISE National Action Plans, which translate the project's findings into actionable measures to tackle local challenges, are presented.

CHAISE Learning Resources

To tackle blockchain skills mismatches in Europe and create a EU blockchain skills ecosystem, CHAISE has developed a comprehensive package of free learning resources available in 11 European language. The developed resources are part of "Mastering blockchain and Distributed Ledger technology", CHAISE blockchain skills online course available on the Thinkfic MOOC platform, but are also available in downloadable format on CHAISE website. CHAISE blockchain skills online course Is designed to provide a solid knowledge in blockchain and DLT for both students looking to pursue a career in this industry and professionals in the tech world who want to upskill or enhance their existing knowledge in blockchain technology. In addition, learners have the opportunity to choose between three specialisation learning pathways: Blockchain Developer, Blockchain Manager and Blockchain Architect for which they can receive a certification. To be certified as one of these job profiles, the learner must collect theory and practical badges for each of the 12 modules of the course. The achievement of a theory or practical badge leads to the award of a module certificate.

As the CHAISE course includes many



The CHAISE online course certification strategy is largely based on the principles of the International standard ISO/IEC 17024:2012-07 conformity assessment - general requirements. So far more that 700 learners have enrolled in the the CHAISE blockchain skills online course and this number is expected to grow in the near future.

In addition to this, CHAISE has designed a Trainer's Guide to provide trainers with guidelines and resources to deliver an optimized and impactful learning experience on blockchain and distributed ledger technologies. The guide is available for all educators who wish to online conduct in-person or blockchain training and explains how ICT trainers can deliver the CHAISE course lectures in both informal and formal settings.

Once the learner has successfully obtained the theory and practical and badge for a module, they will be awarded with the module certificate. After receiving the certification of each module, the learner will obtain the full course certification, which will be issued by CHAISE partner ECQA.

CHAISE Forecast 2024



The CHAISE partnership has released its Blockchain skills forecast for 2024, which entails the most up-to-date estimates on blockchain skills demand and supply in Europe. CHAISE Forecast 2024 was developed using both quantitative and qualitative methods to offer an in-depth analysis of the blockchain landscape in Europe. The report examines the current state of blockchain technology diffusion, its practical applications, and the evolving nature of blockchain skill requirements in various industries.

A key feature of the CHAISE Forecast 2024 is its detailed analysis of occupational variations in blockchain skills demand throughout Europe. In collaboration with CHAISE Consortium members, the report identifies and provides the annual update for the key occupational profiles in the blockchain sector. Additionally, it assesses how education and training courses are adapting to meet the dynamic skills demand in blockchain the sector. This information is crucial for understanding the evolving blockchain market landscape and helps guide both professionals and educational institutions in preparing for future blockchain-related roles.



CHAISE National Action Plans

The CHAISE consortium created with a common approach, 13 National Action Plans in order to share visibility and mainstream project results.

The National Action Plans interpreted project results and lessons learnt throughout the project duration into specific measures and activities to address territorial (national or regional) specificities and challenges, in line with the European Blockchain Skills Strategy created during the course of the project.

National plans are expected to lead to new national blockchain (Skills) strategies or thematically broader policy instrument or bring structural changes in existing ones, and allocate more funds for restructuring educational systems and for the roll-out of blockchain solutions/services.



All partners will circulate own country's action plan to national stakeholders for feedback. consultation and and promote National Blockchain Skills Partnerships to secure a critical mass of participating stakeholders.

CHAISE National Information Days

From May to October 2024, the CHAISE partnership held its National Information Days across 13 European countries including: Austria, Bulgaria, Belgium, Estonia, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Romania, Slovenia, Spain.

This event series was designed to disseminate the project's outputs and results to sector stakeholders, education and training providers, and public authorities at the national and regional regional level.

During the CHAISE National Information Days, participants had the chance to gain insights into the key project's outputs, including the CHAISE blockchain skills course and learning resources and CHAISE blockchain skills forecasting activities.

Additionally, several panels held during the events provided a valuable opportunity for attendees to exchange expertise, share ideas, and network with industry professionals.

EBSI-VECTOR Piloting



In the EBSI-Vector project, CHAISE partner CIMEA is coordinating the onboarding of institutions to implement European Blockchain Services Infrastructure (EBSI) capabilities in the educational domain.

By now, more than 30 institutions have joined, and the pre-production phase is expected to conclude by May 2025.

Participating institutions will have the opportunity to integrate their services for the following use cases: Transcript and Academic Record Management, Employer Verification Scenarios, Student Card Verification & Revocation Scenarios, and Publishing & Copyright Protection.
